## **House Support**

House Support is the minimum expected aggregate expenditure that members must spend with Club bar, catering and/or merchandise each half-year period ending the last day of October and April each financial year.

Members whose aggregate Club bar, catering and merchandise purchases is less than their House Support amount at the end of the relevant half year House Support period, must pay a "shortfall levy" equivalent to the amount of that shortfall and have their Club account debited with that levy. The House Support amount is proportional to membership fees.

## **Family Membership**

RFBYC welcomes families and a 20% discount applies on entrance fees when joining as a family (Ordinary 36 + Associate + at least one Junior).

Members' spouses (Associate members) and Juniors Under 16 members pay 10% of the full subscriptions (Ordinary 36+) each year, making family membership great value.

Sailing Excellence, Travel Grant and Ron Tough donations assist the elite sailors representing the Club at national and international regattas. These donations are applied to your account throughout the year.

No member may place a vessel in the marina unless it is on the Club register.

#### Pen & Security Fees

Pen fees for 2023/2024 are based on a rate of \$91.30 per square metre plus 6% boat security fee, which equals \$96.78. A catwalk fee of \$267.10 is charged (where applicable). A refundable pen rental deposit equal to 1.14 times the annual pen rental is payable on allocation. Pen fees are charged annually unless members elect to pay quarterly. In this case a premium of 4% will apply.

# SLIPPING FACILITIES MAINTENANCE HARDSTANDING

During the sailing season hardstanding for maintenance, other than space for the mobile cradles, is restricted to the area immediately adjacent to the slips for two to three vessels and a small area on the western boundary fence. In winter, hardstanding for maintenance extends on to the car parking area south and west of the slips and the shed on the western boundary.

## **BOOKED THROUGH THE SHIPWRIGHTS**

Longer periods are available but only with the approval of the Chief Executive Officer and subject to other bookings.

These charges exclude any service or maintenance charge which may be charged by the shipwrights.
