

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS MID WEEK AND FROSTBITE INVITATION SERIES

Events will be conducted in accordance with the 2023-24 Standard Keelboat Sailing Instructions subject to these additions or amendments. In the event of a conflict, these Supplementary Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

1. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Entry to Mid-Week and Frostbite Series is open to any boat registered with a club affiliated with Australian Sailing and helmed by a member of that club.

2. SAILS

Spinnakers shall not be used in the Mid-Week Series.

3. FLEETS AND COMBINATIONS

Mid Week Series

Fleet A: Division I, SB, IRC, Etchells, BW8

Fleet B: All other classes

Fleet C: Contender/Dinghies

Frostbite Series

Fleet A: Division I, SB, IRC, Etchells, BW8

Fleet B: All other classes

4. IDENTIFICATION

Fleet A: Code Flag 'A'

Fleet B: Code Flag 'B'

Fleet C: Contender Class Flag

Boats are not required to display Division or Class Flags.

5. COURSES

Courses are detailed in the 2023-2024 Standard Keelboat Sailing Instructions Addendum B 'Courses' and are also available from the Club website.

5.1 Mid Week Series

The course may be shortened in the following ways:

- i) Flag 'S' displayed with two sound signals and the activation of the orange flashing light mounted on the top of the Start Box means 'after rounding the mark of the course indicated by a hashtag (#), proceed directly to the finishing line to finish in the direction of the course from that mark. This changes RRS 32.2.
- ii) The RC may also advise of a shortened course at any mark, via announcement of the Fleet the shortened course applies to and the mark, on VHF Channel 62. The RO will repeat the announcement three times at approximately 30 second intervals. After rounding this mark boats shall proceed directly to the finish line.
NOTE: The RC may advise that the shortened course instruction applies to all or just certain Fleets, classes or divisions. This changes RRS 32.2.

5.2 Frostbite Series

The course may be shortened as follows:

- i) SI 11.3 applies.

- ii) The RC may also advise of a shortened course at any mark, via announcement of the Fleet the shortened course applies to and the mark, on VHF Channel 62. The RC will repeat the announcement three times at approximately 30 second intervals. After rounding this mark boats shall proceed directly to the finish line.

NOTE: The RC may advise that the shortened course instruction applies to all or just certain Fleets, classes or divisions. This changes RRS 32.2.

- iii) Courses may also be shortened in accordance with RRS 32.

6. MISSING MARK

If a mark of the course is missing, boats shall round at the approximate position of its usual location. This changes RRS 34.

7. TIME LIMIT

7.1 Mid Week Series

The time limit is 2 hours 30 minutes after the start of Fleet B.

7.2 Frostbite Series

The time limit is 13:00 hrs for morning races and 17:00 hrs for afternoon races.

Boats that fail to finish before the time limit will be scored 'DNF'. This changes RRS 35.

8. SCORING

8.1 Mid Week Series

The best 17 races in each series shall count.

8.2 Frostbite Series

All races shall count.

9. PRIZES

Pennants will be awarded for each race and series for each fleet as follows:

9.1 Mid Week Series

PHS

1st, 2nd & 3rd place and Fastest Time

AMS Non-Spinnaker

1st, 2nd & 3rd place

IRC Non-Spinnaker

1st, 2nd & 3rd place and Fastest Time

BW8

1st, 2nd & 3rd place and Fastest Time

9.2

Frostbite Series

PHS

1st, 2nd & 3rd place and Fastest Time

AMS

1st, 2nd & 3rd place

IRC

1st, 2nd & 3rd place and Fastest Time

- 9.3 For AMS,IRC or BW8 boats a minimum of two starters is required for pennants to be awarded and for that handicap system or fleet to be scored for the overall series.

- 9.4 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

- 9.5 Trophies will be awarded to the overall winner of each fleet for:

Mid- Week Spring/Summer Series.

Mid-Week Autumn/Winter Series.

Frostbite Series
