Code of Conduct

It is the responsibility of Sailors to comply with the following Code of Conduct to ensure a safe, inclusive and fair sporting environment:

- + Sailing is governed by a set of rules. All sailors are expected to sail by the rules and improve their knowledge of the rules.
- + Be a good sport. Acknowledge all good sailing and be positive in all situations.
- + Control your temper. Any form of abuse is not acceptable, on or off the water.
- + Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- + Cooperate with all officials and volunteers. Without them, sailing would not happen.
- + Never argue with an official. If you disagree with an official ruling, there are processes available to resolve a problem.
- + Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.
- + Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit. The rewards for your effort will come eventually if you try your best.
