Club Boats

Club boats are provided to all dinghy sailors learning to sail before committing to the purchase of their own dinghy. When borrowing a Club boat, it is always important to care for it and return it in a seaworthy condition so it is ready to sail safely by the next sailor.

These are Safety Sam's rules when borrowing a Club Boat:

- 1. Look after a Club Boat as if it was your own.
- 2. Sign on and off the Club Boat register before and after use.
- 3. Before sailing, check boat, rigging and sails. Confirm rigging is intact and there are no missing parts.
- 4. After use, thoroughly wash down boat, rigging and sails. Check there is no water left inside hull. Fit the boat cover.
- 5. Return boat, rigging, sails and trolley to allocated storage bay and racks. Do not leave on the lawn.
- 6. Complete damage report if any repair or replacement is required.

- If using the same Club Boat on repeated occasions, then conduct minor repairs and replacements yourself.
- 8. Do not remove or borrow any equipment from the Club Boat for use on other dinghies.
