WASZP and Moth State Championships 9, 10 and 11 December 2022

- [NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by a boat
- [DP] denotes a rule of which the penalty is at discretion of the protest committee and may be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except as any of these is altered by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions and/or the WASZP and Moth Class rules.
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing Prescriptions shall apply to all entries.
- 1.3 [DP] The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach, will apply.
- 1.4 Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: The two-turns penalty in rule 44.1 is replaced by a part-turn. A part-turn is described as a gybe and coming to close-hauled on a windward leg or a tack and sailing below 90 degrees on any other leg.
- 1.5 Appendix T will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

[DP] Boats may be required to display advertising as chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the WASZP and Moth Class.
- 3.2 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a Club recognised by the competitor's National Authority. Proof of affiliated Club membership to be submitted with entry
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee, by 1700 hrs on 2 December 2022.

- 3.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 3.5 All helms less than 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry for this event is \$100
- 4.2 For late entries, an additional \$50 Late Fee shall apply.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 The schedule of Races will be as follows:

- 5.2 The Championship racing will consist of a maximum of 10 races for each class.
- 5.3 There will be 3 sessions of Championship racing with up to 4 back to back races to be sailed in any session.
- 5.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1800hrs.

6. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

All boats shall comply with RRS 78.1. Boats may be inspected at any time.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available prior to the event.

8. VENUE & COURSE AREAS

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue and course areas.

9. COURSES

Championship racing will be on windward/leeward courses as described in the sailing instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed as described in NOR 1.4.
- 10.2 The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1(B) is changed to 25%.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 A minimum of three races shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 a) When fewer than 4 Championship races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of the boats' race scores.
 - b) When 4 to 7 Championship races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of the boats' race scores excluding the boats' worst score.
 - c) When 8 or more Championship races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of the boats' race scores excluding the boats' two worst scores

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats are allowed and shall be registered with the OA and shall have a working VHF radio for communications with Race Committee and shall act as rescue boats if required to do so. [DP]

13. PRIZES

13.1 WASZP State Championship

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.

13.2 Moth State Championships

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.

- 13.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.
- 13.4 Presentation of prizes will take place at the Dinghy Training Centre at 19:00 on Sunday, 11 December 2022.

14. INSURANCE

- 14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD\$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent in currency.
- 14.2 Proof of Insurance shall be provided on registration.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 15.2 The Organising Authority, host club or their staff and volunteers will not accept any liability for any damage or loss caused to boats berthed at the event.
