These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI) shall govern this event together with the ORWA Notice of Race, Individual Race Notice for the Roland Smith Ocean Race, ORWA Sailing Instructions and information contained in the Ocean Racing WA Handbook 2020-2021. In the event of conflict these SSI's shall prevail.

1. WARNING SIGNALS

2. THE START

- 2.1 The Vessel "Tam Thompson" flying the RFBYC burgee will be the Committee Boat and will start the race.
- 2.2 The Start Line will be between the staff displaying an orange flag on the Committee Boat mast at the starboard end and a black and white checkered buoy at the port end. A clearance mark may be streamed from the Committee Boat. This clearance mark is deemed to be part of the Start Boat for the purpose of RRS 31 and shall be passed on the same side as the Committee Boat when starting.
This changes SI 8.3.
- 2.3 If there are less than three Double Handed entries then the Race Officer may choose not to run the start sequence for this division and to combine Double Handed with Division 2.

3. COURSE

- 3.1 The course is listed in the Ocean Racing WA Handbook 2020-2021.
- 3.2 All marks shall be rounded unless otherwise listed as a pass or gate.

4. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 4.1 Radio checks, will be conducted by "Offshore Race Control" and this station will be on air from 0800 on Saturday 17 April on VHF CH 72. Attention to SI 19.1.

5. MANDATORY POSITION REPORTING

- 5.1 Boats shall report to "Offshore Race Control" on VHF CH 72 for finishing when abeam of Burnell Buoy on approach to the finish.

6. ANCHORS

No anchor shall be carried on deck forward of the stem or with any part protruding outboard.

7. OUTSIDE COMMUNICATIONS

A boat may post social media reports to their team social media account during the race.

8. PROTESTS

- 8.1 Yachts intending to lodge a protest or request for redress shall advise Offshore Race Control at the first reasonable opportunity after finishing. Protests shall be delivered in person or by email to a member of the Race Committee or the RFBYC Offshore Administrator (offshore@rfbyc.asn.au) within the time limit.
- 8.2 In the result of a protest or request for redress being lodged, provisional results will be posted until the outcome has been determined.

9. RACE RESULTS & TROPHIES

The results for the Roland Smith Ocean Race will be published to the ORWA results page and event website as soon as reasonably possible following the completion of the race.

Pennants will be presented at the sailing presentation to be held at Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club at 6pm on Saturday 17 April.
